Crossnet Rhythm

Tuesday Evening – a meeting for those committed to the Crossnet Community

We eat together, worship, and share what Scriptures we are applying in our lives. We pray for one another and for our non-Christian friends. This will usually take place at 27 Carnarvon Road.

Once a month we will have an open meeting organized by a member of the community and with a specific focus on people outside the community.

Friday and Saturday

All members, as much as is possible, will be in touch either through the Facebook group or email with prayer requests and updates about what's happening.

Sunday – late afternoon

There will be a service at Holy Trinity Hotwells open for anyone and everyone. Normally this will be a joint venture of Crossnet and HTH. Once a month, Hope Chapel will join in. This will give us an opportunity to meet with other Christians in Hotwells, to have a longer period of teaching and worship and to pray for the people who attend.

Annual Conference Gathering

Crossnet will hold an annual conference on discipleship to which all Crossnet members are invited.
